EYE EXAM PROCESS

 Involves tests like visual acuity, refraction, and evaluation of eye health. • Helps identify refractive errors, detect eye diseases, and assess visual function.



POST-EYE EXAM CONSIDERATIONS

• Pupil Dilation: Dilated pupils increase light sensitivity and can cause temporary blurriness.

- Blurry Vision: Vision may be temporarily blurry due to dilation process or prescription changes.
- · Discomfort: Some exams involve bright lights and close examination.

TRANSITIONING BACK TO DRIVING • Wait 30 minutes to an hour after the exam.

- · Bring a companion for assistance or drive home.
- Wear sunglasses to reduce glare and light sensitivity.
